ORDINANCE NO. 12-02-A

**AMENDMENT TO THE ORDINANCE
RELATING TO GARBAGE COLLECTION AND RATES**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF LOUISA, KENTUCKY, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 3: Prohibited Items:

The following waste may not be disposed of in the City's system:

1. Hazardous waste;
2. Liquid wastes;
3. Bulky wastes, major appliances, furniture;
4. Tires;
5. Construction and demolition wastes;
6. Dead animals;
7. Any burning or smoldering materials or any other materials that would create a fire hazard;
8. Batteries;
9. Animal waste;
10. Chemicals;
11. Explosives or other volatile substances;
12. Gasoline or oils or other liquid hydrocarbons;
13. Herbicides;
14. Industrial or commercial wastes of any type;
15. Liquids other than those contained in customary household solid waste;
16. Metal wire in large amounts;
17. Motor vehicles;
18. Nuclear or radioactive waste;
19. Pathological wastes;
20. Pesticides;
21. Poisons;
22. Road construction material including, but not limited to asphalt, gravel, etc.;
23. Sludge's of semi-solid fluids;

24. Stumps, logs or tree limbs;
25. ~~Grass clippings, leaves and other yard wastes;~~
26. Toxic wastes; or
27. All other hazardous wastes.

Grass clippings, leaves, and other yard waste may be collected by the City but only if the City has the available manpower and disposal areas to do so.

No person may remove any item from a solid waste receptacle, climb on or into a container or receptacle, or damage any container.

SECTION 4: Garbage bags, containers, or dumpsters. All customers shall comply with the following requirements:

[a] Each customer shall be required to place their garbage in a plastic garbage bag or metal or plastic containers of not less than twenty [20] gallons or more than thirty two [32] gallons capacity.

[b] All garbage must be set out for collection no later than 7:00 a.m., on the day designated for pick up.

[c] There is a six [6] bag limit per customer on garbage pickup. Any bags over the six [6] bag limit will be left until the following week.

[d] All sharp objects such as broken glass, razor blades, used hypodermic needles, etc., should be placed in a puncture proof container before being placed in the trash.

[e] Customers with dumpsters shall place all garbage in the dumpsters and areas around the dumpster shall be maintained free of debris and obstructions.

Garbage not in a dumpster shall not be collected.

[f] The City shall not be responsible for picking up trash that has been spread by an animal;

[g] If one dumpster is not sufficient to hold the quantity of garbage accumulated between collections, it is the responsibility of the customer to provide a sufficient number of dumpsters;

[h] Boxes, papers and off articles shall be bundled in lengths not to exceed five [5] feet and not fifty [50] pounds in weight, where practicable, and must be placed in dumpsters.

[i] All boxes must be broken down and put in the dumpster.

[j] Parking lots leading to the area where dumpsters are kept shall be cleared of snow and ice. If the area is not safe, the truck may not pick up garbage and the customer may be held responsible in case of accident.

[k] Garbage shall be placed reasonably near the curb for pickup except as follows:

[i] Those who are physically disabled or with other special needs may request to have their garbage picked up from their residence. Such person[s] shall submit an application, upon a form to be provided by the City Clerk's Office, to the City Clerk or Deputy City Clerk who shall then approve or disapprove the application. Such application shall provide for a waiver of liability by the applicant for any injury or damages caused, in whole or part, by City employees as a result of such pick ups.


[ii] Residents of trailer parks shall place their garbage in an easily accessible location outside their trailer for pick up.

All other provisions of the prior Ordinance and Amendments thereto shall remain unchanged.

This Amendment shall be in full force and effect upon publication.
